Entry Level & Level 1 training Learning for Living and Work

Applications are invited from people with learning difficulties or disabilities who have been unable to access mainstream education. The training is a four-year programme made up of vocational, functional, personal and social learning. Please complete and submit an application form if you would like to be considered for inclusion in the training programme **starting January 2022**. The entry criteria are:

- A person with learning difficulties,
- or a person with physical disabilities,
- or a person with autism or a similar developmental condition,
- who has a minimum age of 14 years,
- and is unable to access mainstream, secondary education,
- preference will be given to the selection of learners who are normally resident in a geographical area bounded by Ramatlabama, Jwaneng, Molepolole, Mochudi and Ramotswa,
- It is unlikely Camphill Community Trust will be able to offer a place to a person with a severe disability who requires on-going personal care.
